Outline of the Event: - Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Memorial Society Deekdhabhoomi, Chandrapur was founded in the year 1967 under the chairmanship of Barrister Rajabhau Khobragade. Chandrapur Deekdhabhoomi came to be known as one of the most famous Dhammadiksha place in the world because of Dr. Ambedkar’s ordination of Buddha Dhamma to people on 16th Oct 1956 Dr. Ambedkar’s adopted son Bar. Rajabhau khobragade and Bar. Rajabhau’s father Devajibapu Khobragade made a significant contribution in inviting Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar for this Dhammachakra ceremony. Chandrapur Deekshabhoomi has over the years become a holy land, a place of enlightenment. On this holy land about three lakh people took Diksha of Buddhism and freeing themselves from clutches of orthodox mentality becomes one with Buddhism. Dr. Ambedkar’s visit to a place like Chandrapur which is tribal and backward and his Dikshadan to people is regarded as the most auspicious moment for the people of this city as well as this region. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Memorial Society, Deekdhabhoomi, Chandrapur is celebrating begging

to preserve the culture heritage of Dr. Ambedkar. The year 1991 was the birth centenary year of Dr. Ambedkar. In the same year, Hon'ble Arun Ghotekar was unanimously elected as the president of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Memorial Society, Chandrapur. Since then Hon'ble Arun Ghotekar and all the Hon'ble office bearers of the society have been organizing Dhammadiksha celebration day every year on a grand scale.

In order to spread Buddhism, Samrat Ashoka sangamitra took a branch of Bodhivriksha from Bodhgaya to Srilanka and from Anuradhapur in Srilanka a branch of same Bodhivriksha was brought to Deekshabhoomi Chandrapur. In this regard Hon'ble President Arun Ghotekar especially requested Indian High commissioner in Srilanka and the same branch of Bodhivriksha was planted on Deekshabhoomi by the Hon'ble High commissioner, His highness Mangalmungalsinghe on 16 Oct 1996. On this auspicious occasion every year Bhante Arya Nagarjun Surai Sasai, and his sangha as well as Tibetan religious leader Karmappa Lama and Sangha and several Buddhist monks from Thailand, Japan, China, Srilanka and Myanmar attend programme and impart Dhammadesana to the congregation in addition to this world renowned scholars and Ambedkarite thinkers attend this event every year.

The entire programme on Deekshabhoomi was conducted by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Memorial Society Deekshabhoomi, Chandrapur. Every year on 15 and 16 Oct the Dhammadiksha Anniversary programme "Dhammachakra Anupravartan Day" is celebrated on a grand scale. Still people consider Deekshabhoomi as a source of inspiration of Ambedkarite movement. Everyday people from the nook and corner of the world visit this holy place.

This year also on 15 and 16 Oct, 66th Dhammachakra Anuvavartan day was celebrated with great enthusiasm on a grand scale by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Memorial Society Deekshabhoomi, Chandrapur. In this two days programme world renowned Buddhist scholars, monks and Ambedkarite thinkers attended the event. For this grand event preparation started almost three months before. Several stalls were set up in Deekshabhoomi area books stalls, food stalls, drinking water. Several social organizations as well as government employees' organization make arrangement for the pilgrims. District Administration, Police Department, Zilla Parishad, Municipal Corporation, Social Welfare Department extended their whole hearted Co-operation for this event.

On 15 Oct 2022 the programme went on between 4:00 to 8:00 pm. The programme began with paying tribute to the statue of Vishvaratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar located in the heart of the city. A huge vehicle rally was taken out from the statue of Dr. Ambedkar to Deekshabhoomi spreading the message of universal peace and brotherhood. On reaching Deekshabhoomi, Dhammajyoti was lighted and Dhammaflag was hoisted at the hands of Hon'ble Shri. Arunji Ghotekar President of the Society. Rev. Bhadant Dyanjoyti Mahasthvir and Vice President Hon'ble Ashok Ghotekar. On the occasion as chief guests Chandrapur District Collector Shri. Vinay Gouda G.C, District Superintendent of Police Shri. Arvind Salve, Municipal Co-operation Commissioner Mr. Vipin Paliwal was prominently present. All the Buddhist monks from various places were also present. The programme was concluded with common prayer "Buddhavandana" and Dhamma teaching.

In the evening at 8:00 to 10:00 pm a social enlightening musical cultural programme based on Dr. Ambedkar life was presented by famous Singer Shri. Rahul Anvikar, Nanded. About one lakh people gathered to witness the cultural programme. Inspired by Dr. Ambedkar's message on conversion the congregation spent the whole night on Deekshabhoomi.

On 16 October under the guidance of Hon'ble Arunji Ghotekar and the office bearers of the society, Buddhist monk Arya Nagarjuna Bhante Surai Sasai, Nagpur and his Sangha in the presence of Principal, Dr. Ambedkar college, Chandrapur, Teaching and non-teaching staff Dhammadiksha Anniversary Celebration began. Since morning, followers of Buddha across the world started gathering on Deekshabhoomi. 66th Anniversary of Conversion to Buddhism was a

day of freedom to them. To witness that great moment, all of gratitude through their eyes a deep sense of gratitude to their torch bearer, savior. All these people seemed to be giving outlet to their deep feelings.

At 10:00 a.m. after paying tribute to the statue of Dr. Ambedkar, located the heart of the city and taking the holy pot containing (ashes) Asthi of Dr. Ambedkar Rev. Buddhist Monks, Samata Sainik Dal, which is created then by Dr. Ambedkar, made a march past towards Deekshabhoomi. Slogan's emphasizing the victory of Buddhism and Dr. Ambedkar and everlasting continuity of Dhammachakra were shouted on the way. Along its way, people were thronging on the both sides of the roads to have a glimpse of Dr. Ambedkar's Asthikalash (a pot containing holy remains of Dr. Ambedkar). The rally moved in a much disciplined way and followed all the safety norms. At 11:00 a.m. under the chairmanship of Eminent Ambedkarite Thinker Shri Rajesh Wankhed, MP, a seminar on "Dhammakranti and its Relevance," was conducted. Renowned Ambedkarite thinker Shri. Chandrabhau Thakare, Nagpur, Dr. Santosh Raut, Hyderabad, Dr. Laxamaya, Hyderabad were prominently present as a chief guest.
